

STANDARD BANK PRIVATE INTERNATIONAL PAIRS 2024 SOUTH AFRICAN FINAL

LOCAL ON-COURSE RULES:

1. **OUT OF BOUNDS - RULE 18:** All private property and estate boundaries. Areas indicated by white stakes to the right of holes 2, 3, 4 and to the left of holes 4, 8, 11, 12, and 13.
2. **ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS (INCLUDING IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS) - RULE 16**
 - Ground under repair is defined by any area encircled by a white line.
 - Areas of damage in bunkers caused by antelope are treated as ground under repair from which relief is allowed under Rule 16.1b. However, relief is not allowed if the damage only interferes with the player's stance.
 - Relief is not allowed if animal damage interferes with the player's stance.
3. **INTEGRAL OBJECTS:** All roads and pathways are integral parts of the course unless artificially surfaced, from which free relief is allowed under Rule 16.1. Riveted bunker faces are integral parts of the course and are not part of the bunker.
4. **DISTANCE MARKERS:** All distances on Par 4's and Par 5's are measured to the front edge of the greens. All distances on Par 3's are measured to the middle of the greens.
5. **PIN FLAGS:** All flags are white; please check the pin sheet for hole allocations.
6. **PREFERRED LIES (PLACING):** A ball lying on a closely mown area through the green may be lifted, cleaned, and placed within one club length from its original position, not nearer the hole.
7. **BUNKER FACES:** Artificial stacked bunker faces are integral objects of the course. There is no free relief from such faces and also no free relief for a ball embedded in or under such a face.
8. **ROADS AND PATHWAYS:** Free relief is available from all paved cart paths and the bare sand or gravel entrance and exit of the cart path.
9. **TREES & WATERING BOWLS:** Trees under 2 meters in height: relief can be obtained at the nearest point of relief within one club length without penalty; this includes the watering bowls.
10. **ELECTRONIC MEASURING DEVICES:** Distance measuring devices may be used during the tournament, provided they are used for measuring direct distance only.
11. **IF YOU ARE UNSURE OF ANY RULING, APPLY THE 2-BALL RULE:** If a player and his marker cannot come to a conclusion on a ruling, the player is permitted to play two balls on the hole and record both scores. The player finishes the hole with both possible outcomes of the ruling. It is required that the player indicates which ball he/she would prefer to stand. The rule shall be settled by rules officials after the round.
12. **UNSAFE PLAYING CONDITIONS - THUNDER AND LIGHTNING:** A horn will be sounded if the tournament committee decides that playing conditions are unsafe to continue. A player is to immediately mark their ball and return to the clubhouse. No further play is allowed after the horn has been sounded.

IMPORTANT: NO CARTS ARE ALLOWED WITHIN 10 METERS OF ANY GREEN OR TEE-BOX. No carts are allowed left of hole 17; please keep to the right of the 17th green.

Each player will receive 30 balls for warmup at the driving range. You are welcome to purchase more from the pro shop if needed.

NO CADDIES OR OUTSIDE CADDIES: Please note that no caddies or outside caddies are allowed on the course.

FORMAT:

The tournament is a 36-hole (2 rounds of 18), betterball-stableford competition. Note, if you can not make points on the hole pick up and move to the next hole to keep up with the pace of play.

HANDICAPPING:

All players will be playing off their low-hi (low handicap index) as indicated on their HNA profile. 85%

Handicap Calculation: All players will receive a 85% handicap allowance on Better Ball Stableford. (E.g.; if your low index is 9,8 and equals to a 10 playing handicap from your selected tee box, your handicap will be 8.5 – which is rounded up to a 9 playing handicap.)

TEE-BOX SELECTION:

Players will be allowed to select their tee box color should they wish and their playing handicap will adjust accordingly. The change of tee box must be communicated to tournament organisers before teeing off.

You are allowed to change tee box for day 1 and day 2.
